Notification

In efforts to further reinforce the preparedness and response measures to COVID-19 along the international borders, the following *additional measures to prevent and contain local transmission in high-risk areas* shall be enforced and implemented with immediate effect from 25th May 2020:

Objective: To mitigate the risk of introduction of COVID-19 into the country through prevention of community transmission in high risk area.

<i>Strategies</i>	<i>Additional Measures</i>
<i>Test</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Periodic testing of high-risk communities and frontline responders along the borders
<i>Trace</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage the use of Druk Trace App or registry to be maintained in all public places including public transport Restrict movement from 7:00 pm Fever screening (if required RDT) shall be carried out at the strategic check posts between border districts and other interior districts Documentation of contact information and travel history of all travellers shall be maintained
<i>Treat</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure adequate supply of PPE, essential medicine and health human resources
<i>Public Health Measures</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Enforce physical distancing and hand washing stations in all public places Recommend use of mask in the public places including health facilities Highly discourage non-essential gathering at all times
