1. The Royal Government of Bhutan (RGoB) has applied for grant from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of Health Sector Development Program. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from **eligible source countries of the ADB**. However, a successful bidder is required to register with the Construction Development Board (CDB) of Bhutan before award of contract.
2. The Project Management and Policy Support Unit, ADB Health Sector Development Program, Ministry of Health ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the construction and completion of "Renovation and Small Works at BHU-IIs, BHU-Is, and Hospitals" in Pemagatshel and Samdrup Jongkhar Dzongkhags ("the Works").
3. Open Competitive Bidding-national advertising (OCB) will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Single-Stage: Two-Envelope Bidding Procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible bidders with following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:
 - a) **Key Construction Experience Requirement:** Participation in at least **1 (one)** contract that have been successfully or substantially completed within the last **5 (five)** years and that are similar to the proposed works (similar works means similar Civil works), where the value of the Bidder's participation exceeds: **Nu 22.00 million**.
 - b) **Key financial requirement:** Minimum Average Annual Construction Turnover (AACT) of **Nu 22 million**.
 - c) **Key equipment requirement:** (i) Tipper truck – 2 nos.; (ii) Concrete mixer machine 7/5 cft or higher capacity – 2 nos.; (iii) JCB or equivalent backhoe excavator/ loader – 2 nos.; and (iv) Concrete vibrator with 2 sets nozzle – 3 sets.
 - d) **Key personnel requirement:** (i) Project Manager – 1; (ii) Project Engineer – 2; and (iii) Site Supervisor – 4.
